Here is a list of important bills addressing the impact of COVID-19 that have become law. Click the bill number to see more details.

<u>A3840</u> - School districts must continue to provide meals or meal vouchers to students eligible for free-and reduced-price school meals while their schools are closed due to COVID-19 epidemic.

<u>A3843</u> - Requires health insurance and Medicaid coverage for testing of coronavirus disease and for telemedicine and telehealth during coronavirus state of emergency.

<u>A3845</u> - Allows the NJ Economic Development Authority to make grants and extend deadlines for submitting business documentation.

<u>A3848</u> - Employers cannot terminate or refuse to rehire an employee who requests or takes time off based on a recommendation from a medical professional during the state of emergency declared by the Governor.

<u>A3855</u> - All executive branch departments of state government must display information about how to get food on the statewide 2-1-1 system and their websites and social media pages during public health emergencies.

<u>S2304</u> - Assures that workers can take the leave they need to care for themselves and their families if they have communicable diseases.
