- HHS has launched a <u>web-based locator</u> for COVID-19 outpatient treatment sites to help healthcare providers and patients find potential locations for treatment with monoclonal antibody therapeutics.
- HHS announced that the Trump Administration Purchased an Additional 100 Million
 Doses of COVID-19 Investigational Vaccine from Pfizer
- HHS announced it has purchased another million doses of the investigational vaccine from Moderna bringing the total count of doses owned by the Federal government to 200 million. Doses will begin shipping immediately after authorization is provided by the FDA.

- HHS, through the Health Resources and Services Administration (HRSA) announced a \$2 billion Provider Relief Fund (PRF) performance-based <u>incentive payment distribution</u> program for nursing homes.
- <u>The Healthy People 2030 Report</u> details the U.S.' 10-year-plan for addressing our most critical public health priorities and challenges including opioid use disorder, youth e-cigarette use and emerging public health threats like COVID-19.
- HHS has extended the application deadline to August 28th for Phase 2 general distribution to Medicaid, Medicaid managed care, Children's Health Insurance Program (CHIP) and dental providers and provided certain Medicare providers who experienced challenges in the Phase 1 Medicare General Distribution application period a second opportunity to receive funding.
