

Archive of NJ Bills Signed into Law

220th Session (2022-2023)

- [A3092](#) Requires state agencies update demographic data collection methods on Asian, Native Hawaiian, Pacific Islander, Middle Eastern, North African, and South Asian and Indian Diaspora residents of this State.
- [A4049](#) Provides for presumptive eligibility for home and community-based services and services provided through program of all-inclusive care for the elderly under Medicaid.
- [A4755](#) Permits behavioral and mental health care providers to operate within homeless shelters.
- [A4772](#) Concerns Unemployment Insurance (UI) benefits during labor disputes. Requires some employers, such as nonprofit healthcare entities, to pay unemployment insurance and staff salaries during labor disputes.
- [A4913](#) Requires carriers to offer health care providers more than one method of payment for reimbursement
- [A4914](#) Establishes “Hospital at Home Act”
- [A5096](#) Replaces statutory terms regarding alcohol and substance use.
- [A5225](#) Provides for coverage of community-based palliative care benefits under Medicaid
- [A5311](#) Enters New Jersey into Counseling Compact.
- [A5748](#) Amends definition of “participating county” under County Option Hospital Fee Program
- [A5757](#) Extends certain pay parity regarding telemedicine and telehealth for one year.
- [A5909](#) Revises workers’ compensation coverage for certain injuries to certain volunteer and professional public safety and law enforcement personnel.
- [S332](#) Requires notification to consumers of collection and disclosure of personal data by certain entities.
- [S524](#) Creates Mental Illness Diversion Program to divert eligible persons away from criminal justice system and into appropriate case management and mental health services.
- [S723](#) Creates “New Jersey Domestic Workers’ Bill of Rights Act.”

S783 - Establishes Opioid Recovery and Remediation Fund; establishes requirements for proceeds from opioid settlements to support substance use disorder prevention and treatment programs. Creates a state Advisory Council.

S1033 Establishes the "Alzheimer's and Dementia Care Long-Term Advisory Commission" in the Department of Human Services (DHS).

S1662 Requires NJ Youth Suicide Prevention Advisory Council to prepare report regarding suicide prevention instruction in public schools.

S2369 Establishes minimum NJ FamilyCare reimbursement rate for traumatic brain injury special care nursing facilities; establishes enhanced NJ FamilyCare reimbursement rate for nursing facilities under certain circumstances; makes an appropriation.

S2389 Establishes employment protections for certain service employees during changes of ownership

S2535 Requires health benefits coverage of hearing aids and cochlear implants.

S2716 Requires NJ FamilyCare to reimburse claims for covered services submitted by clinical social workers, professional counselors, and marriage and family therapists under certain circumstances.

S3275 Requires establishment of new State website with information on rights related to, and health benefits coverage for, reproductive health care services.

S3292 Prohibits persons from receiving compensation for advising or assisting with veterans benefits.

S3604 Authorizes use of healthcare platforms providing discounted prices for payment of prescription and non-prescription drugs or devices and for telehealth and telemedicine services.

S3929 Revises certain requirements for involuntary commitment for mental health treatment.
